Approval of Minutes:

Committee Reports:

Town Council: Councilman Bachalis reported that a presentation was given by the Pinelands Preservation Alliance & NJ Future on aquifer protection, and that interviews for a prospective intern will begin shortly.

One significant question is whether lowering the lake 3 ft. significantly increases risk to the health of the lake ecosystem. Reitmeyer will continue to seek an answer from Chris Smith of the NJDEP.
- **2.** <u>Improved Channel 9 Presence:</u> Reitmeyer has received the proper formatting requirements for items on Channel 9. R. Roesch indicated he will provide slides for the "10 steps". It was also discussed that images of lake activities be provided as well.

New Business:

1. <u>Lakeside Erosion (Ballfield Loop)</u>: Reitmeyer will contact Jerry Barberio to inquire into the status of this area of concern and provide an update to the Committee.
