Parks & Recreation Commission: O. Hernandez reported that the Commission approved not turning on the Clean Flo units and held some discussion on the pet stations being proposed by the Lake Water Quality Advisory Committee.

Environmental Commission: R. Reitmeyer reported that the Commission discussed the 2016 Lake Park Cleanup, and is now focusing on providing a 2016 Arbor Day celebration. A tree donated by Atlantic City Electric will be planted in front of the Post

Office and an Arbor Day presentation will be made to all Hammonton 4th graders who will also receive a tree seedling.
