## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

**Electronics:** ACUA does not accept electronics. The Town of Hammonton collects electronics from **residents only** along with bulky waste items. <http://www.townofhammonton.org/departments-services/highway/electronic-waste-disposal/>

**Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)

**Shredded Paper:** Shredded paper cannot be recycled curbside, but can be recycled at ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in Egg Harbor Township. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)

**Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Offs. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)
